

San Diego Book Project is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to collect books through donations, and in turn, give them to schools, daycare centers, and other deserving organizations at no cost. Many schools and other organizations, both public and private, are experiencing enormous financial difficulties these days, and in addition to cut-backs in staff and building expenses, libraries and book acquisition programs have been particularly hard hit.



Where and When

Barring holidays, book sortings are held the **last Saturday of every month from 9 am–12 noon**. Volunteers come to the old **JEROME's Warehouse located at 841 14th Street , San Diego (down the ramp at the corner of F and 15th)** to sort through boxes and boxes of books which have come from donations. We have both children's books and adult books in all genres...fiction and nonfiction, classics, how-to books, dictionaries, cookbooks, Bibles, encyclopedias, and books written in foreign languages.

Once sorted, the books are ready to be distributed and carted away by teachers and other non-profit organizations on the **first Saturday of every month from 9am–12 noon** (again barring holidays). We are proud that our books have been distributed to many local elementary and high schools throughout San Diego County as well as to hospitals, senior centers and Veteran's associations.
