

REJECTED

Dear Judge Burns,

I am a Director of the Fallbrook PUD. I also have a Masters Degree in Chemical Engineering from New York University, NY, NY. In addition I am a California Registered Professional Civil Engineer. I have worked in water resource engineering for the U.S. Navy on all of the Navy Aircraft Carriers in Service during a 15 year period as a GS 13 Chemical Engineer (equivalent Navy Rank of Commander during shipboard duty). I have also worked for the City of San Diego in water resources engineering and I retired from San Diego City with 18 years of service in July of year 2000.

I am writing in response to the report "U.S.A. Fallbrook Public Utility District et al Civil No. 51-CV-1247-RBB; Annual WATERMASTER Report for Water Year 2010-11 which is the recent WATERMASTER report I received. The report states that I have 15 days to object to any portion of the report but that is not what this communication is about. My name can be found as a recipient of the WATERMASTER report on Page 2.

My concerns are as follows:

- 1) There cannot be even a suggestion of the possibility of collaboration between WATERMASTER, Charles W. Binder and the Fallbrook PUD (FPUD).
- 2) I have been informed by Mr. Steele of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation that FPUD not only provides office space for Mr. Binder but he (Mr. Binder) is employed on a part time basis for 3 days a week by FPUD.
- 3) During the period that GM Lewinger was in charge, Mr. Binder had a shared office space in a general area of the FPUD building complex. Recently, Mr. Binder moved into GM Brady's huge office area (Lewinger's old office) and FPUD GM Brady moved into Mr. Binders old shared office space in the FPUD complex. Mr. Binder's office space has quadrupled under Brady management.
- 4) FPUD General Manager Brady has hired Ruth B. Beglin and Alisa Monian as Administrative Assistants to the WATERMASTER. The salary for Ruth and Alisa
