

## **Attorney Opening**

The Court is seeking applications from attorneys interested in serving as defense counsel for indigent individuals who are charged with misdemeanor and petty offenses committed on federal property, including military bases and national parks. These crimes and citations are handled during the Central Violations Bureau ("CVB") calendar which begins at 8 am on most Wednesdays and concludes by noon. Counsel will be expected to appear in court for every Wednesday morning CVB calendar, although there will be flexibility for CVB defense counsel to cover for each other. Counsel also will be required to periodically attend a monthly CVB calendar held at the El Centro U. S. Courthouse. The chosen attorney(s) will serve through December 31, 2016 and may apply for the following term.

Applications must be submitted by **March 25, 2016** and should be emailed to [efile\\_major@casd.uscourts.gov](mailto:efile_major@casd.uscourts.gov) and [efile\\_bartick@casd.uscourts.gov](mailto:efile_bartick@casd.uscourts.gov). Applicants may apply by submitting a letter, no longer than two pages, detailing counsel's legal experience and qualifications and highlighting experiences, including prior military experience, that would assist counsel in representing CVB defendants.
