O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no party in a criminal case shall submit more than five (5) letters unless authorized by the court for good cause shown.

Additional letters may be submitted to the probation officer who is preparing the presentence report for summarization in the report. Counsel may also submit to the court as part of a sentencing memorandum a brief summary of letters in excess of the amount authorized by this order. Any letters submitted to the court must be filed no later than three (3) days prior to sentencing. The court's staff shall strike from the record any letters filed or submitted in violation of this order and they shall not be made available to the court for review. Thus, any letters submitted in violation of this chamber's order shall not be read by the court or be part of the record.
