John Penn Carter is an expert in California Water Law and Law of the Colorado River. Currently, he serves as Special Counsel to the Vista Irrigation District regarding water rights to the San Luis Rey River. Mr. Carter has negotiated numerous water conservation and transfer agreements, including one between the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California and the San Diego County Water Authority. He also played a key role in drafting California's 4.4 Plan and served as the Imperial Irrigation District's Chief Strategist and Lead Negotiator in the Colorado River Quantification Settlement Agreement.

Donald R. Lincoln has extensive experience representing municipal agencies as special counsel in complex administrative, trial, and appellate proceedings. He has been counsel of record in more than 25 published appellate cases and successfully represented the City of Escondido before the United States Supreme Court in two cases. Mr. Lincoln has also argued as Amicus Curiae on behalf of 76 cities in a mobile home park rent control case before the California Supreme Court.
