

COVID-19 Juror Safety Measures

We are committed to the safety and well-being of our jurors. We are closely following the guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local and U.S. health authorities. The Court has taken precautionary measures to limit the potential spread of the virus while also ensuring that we are able to continue with essential judicial proceedings.

Please be assured the Court is actively monitoring the COVID-19 situation and will make ongoing adjustments to our procedures based upon the recommendations of federal, state and local public health officials. **Jurors who have recently been exposed to COVID-19, or are not feeling well or who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, must stay home and contact the Jury Department (800 998-9035) to reschedule their jury service.**

We are making every effort to protect your health. Jurors perform a vital role in the administration of justice. The following are safety measures in place:

- **All jurors reporting for jury duty will be required to wear masks or face coverings that completely cover the nose and mouth. Masks will be provided if you do not have one.**
- **Sanitizer stations and/or sanitizing wipes will be located throughout the buildings, including the jury assembly areas and courtrooms.**
- **The jury assembly rooms and courtrooms will be cleaned and sanitized before your arrival and also thoroughly cleaned and sanitized at the end of each day.**
- **All court staff will be wearing personal protective equipment when interacting with you.**
- **Maintaining a social distance of at least six feet will be required. Please observe and adhere to floor signage designating standing or seating arrangements when in the jury assembly rooms and in the courtrooms. Signs are posted throughout the courthouses to remind patrons to maintain six feet of social distance.**
- **Elevator cars are restricted to two occupants per car. There will be markers indicating where to stand in the elevators for social distancing purposes.**
- **Light refreshments and meals will be provided by the Court to further limit your public exposure.**
- **Parking will be provided for all jurors at no cost at a nearby parking lot.**
