JUROR PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Jurors reporting for federal jury service may now park **FREE** of charge **ONLY** at HORTON PLAZA PARKING while attending court with proper validation by jury staff. Maximum vehicle height in this lot is 6'8" Parking validation is for Horton Plaza Parking **ONLY**. If you use another Parking facility or any other parking lot, you will **NOT** be reimbursed for parking. Be sure to bring your parking ticket with you for validation, when you report for check in.

DIRECTIONS TO HORTON PLAZA PARKING LOT

I-5 South: Take front Street Exit to Broadway, turn left on Broadway to 4th Avenue, turn Right on 4th Avenue and continue to F Street, then turn Right on F Street which takes you directly into Parking Structure.

I-5 North: Take MLK Jr Frwy/94 East/"J" Street Exit to the first light at Market Street, turn left on Market Street and turn right on 3rd Avenue, which ends at entrance to parking lot

Hwy. 163 South: Hwy. 163 ends downtown and becomes 10th Avenue, turn right on "F" Street which ends at entrance to parking lot

Hwy. 94 West: Hwy. 94 ends downtown and becomes "F" Street, which ends at entrance to parking lot


DISABLED PERSON PARKING PRIVILEGES

Once you have a valid DP placard, DP plates, or DV plates, you may park:

- ▶ In parking spaces with the  International Symbol of Access
- ▶ Next to a blue curb authorized for persons with disabilities parking.
- ▶ In an on-street metered parking space at no charge.
- ▶ In an area that indicates it requires a resident or merchant permit.

NOTE: Due to street closure, please use alternate walking directions from Horton Plaza Parking lot to Jury Assembly room.

Jury Assembly Room, 333 West Broadway, Suite 210, is approximately three blocks from this parking lot. When exiting parking structure on "G" street make a right on G St. Make another Right on 1st Ave. Walk to Broadway Ave., make a left turn on Broadway past Front St. and the Federal Courthouse will be on your left hand side.
