In a declaration of Warden Fernando A. Arriola filed with the Court in Criminal Case No. 11cr3253-BTM, it was represented that the San Diego Metropolitan Correctional Center (MCC) has the highest incidence of pulmonary tuberculosis of any institution in the Bureau of Prisons. Warden Arriola stated that to ensure the safety of the MCC staff, the inmates, and the community, every new inmate receives a chest x-ray to detect any tuberculosis.

Without prejudice to any party in a case challenging the facts in the Warden's declaration, in order to protect the health of the court staff, the U.S. Marshals, the attorneys, and the public, and to avoid the transmission of tuberculosis, the Court enters the following order:

The Department of Justice, through the Bureau of Prisons and the U.S. Marshals Service, shall insure that every detainee being brought before the Court has been screened for and determined not to have transmittable tuberculosis. Such screening shall be completed expeditiously and to avoid unnecessary delay in the detainee's appearance before the Court as required by Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 5.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


