


General Order No. 623

Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 83.7.c, cameras and recording devices that are solely cameras and/or recording devices can not be brought into the United States Courthouse Buildings. Devices that have cameras and recording devices as accessories (such as cell phones, I-pads, etc.) are permitted in the United States Courthouse Buildings. However, the use of cameras and recorders contained in those devices is prohibited as provided in Civil Local Rule 83.7.c. A judge may permit cameras to be brought into the United States Courthouse Buildings in connection with a matter or ceremony before them.


