General Order No. 657

Under authority of General Order 653 of the Southern District of California, the Court and California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) have agreed to participate in a program whereby initial pleadings submitted by prisoners in civil rights cases under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 are electronically filed. The Specific CDCR facility included in this pilot is R.J. Donovan Correctional Facility.

Accordingly, the Court grants R.J. Donovan Correctional Facility a waiver of the fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court. This waiver only applies to the research of prisoner cases in this District's electronic filing program. By accepting this exemption, R.J. Donovan Correctional Facility is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
