General Order No. 675

Having considered the request of Jeffrey Gutman, a professor of Clinical Law at The George Washington University Law School, for a waiver of PACER fees, the Court finds that Mr. Gutman, as an individual researcher associated with an educational institution, falls within the scope of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Mr. Gutman has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary as an individual researcher associated with an educational institution.

Accordingly, the Court grants Mr. Gutman a waiver of the fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of his research of federal civil rights cases filed by individuals who appear on the National Registry of Exonerations. This fee exemption applies only for this research purpose. By accepting this exemption, Mr. Gutman agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption. Furthermore, Mr. Gutman is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet based databases. The exemption is valid until December 31, 2019.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
