General Order No. 676


Having considered the request of Professor Kate Stith of Yale Law School for a waiver of PACER fees, the Court finds that Ms. Stith, as an individual researcher associated with an educational institution, falls within the scope of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Ms. Stith has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary as an individual researcher associated with an educational institution.

Accordingly, the Court grants Ms. Stith a waiver of the fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her research regarding sentencing enhancements under 21 U.S.C § 851. This fee exemption applies only for this research purpose. By accepting this exemption, Ms. Stith agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption. Furthermore, Ms. Stith is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet based databases. The exemption is valid until 12 months from the date this order is filed.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
