General Order No. 680

Having considered the request of Sudha Mani (PACER account number 3524811) for a waiver of PACER fees, the Court finds that Ms. Mani, an individual researcher associated with an educational institution in Australia, falls within the scope of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption.

Accordingly, the Court grants Ms. Mani a waiver of the fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her researching civil cases involving contract enforcement. This fee exemption applies only for this research purpose. By accepting this exemption, Ms. Mani agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption. Furthermore, Ms. Mani is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases. The exemption is valid until October 31, 2019.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
