General Order No. 701

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(f), in an emergency and upon the concurrence of the chief judges of the districts involved, a United States magistrate judge may be temporarily assigned to perform any of the duties specified in subsection (a), (b), or (c) of Section 636 in a judicial district other than the judicial district for which he or she has been appointed. No magistrate judge shall perform any of such duties in a district to which he or she has been temporarily assigned until an order has been issued by the chief judge of such district specifying (1) the emergency by reason of which the magistrate judge is being transferred, (2) the duration of his or her assignment, and (3) the duties which he or she is authorized to perform.

The Southern District of California certifies the need for periodic emergency assistance from the Honorable Jacqueline S. Corley, a magistrate judge in the Northern District of California, to perform the duties designated under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c). The emergency is the increase in criminal filings in the Southern District of California, and specifically the significant number of illegal entry misdemeanor cases filed in the district. During this time, there is a need for an additional magistrate judge to handle the court's daily criminal dockets. The Southern District of California further certifies that it will coordinate its requirements with the Honorable Jacqueline S. Corley so that her assistance will not conflict with the performance of her current assignments to the Northern District of California.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Larry Alan Burns, Chief Judge of the Southern District of California, with the concurrence of the Honorable Phyllis J. Hamilton, Chief Judge of the Northern District of California, hereby designates United States Magistrate Judge Jacqueline S. Corley to hold court and

perform other judicial duties under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c), in the Southern District of California from April 1, 2019 to April 1, 2020, and for such further time as may be required for the judge to complete unfinished business that was assigned to the judge during the one year period.
