**Chief Judge No. 35**

On June 10, 2020, upon the recommendations of the Strategic Committee on Resumption of Regular Court Proceedings, the Chief Judge issued Order of the Chief Judge (OCJ) 29 adopting certain safety protocols for in-person proceedings conducted in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California. Many of the circumstances giving rise to the COVID-19 public emergency have not abated since the entry of OCJ 29 (June 10, 2020) or since the subsequent extension with OCJ 32 (July 6, 2020). To continue to protect the public safety and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Chief Judge hereby extends the safety protocols set forth in OCJ 29.

This Order is effective immediately and will remain in place until September 10, 2020, absent further order of the Court.
