On Friday, April 24, 2020, the County of San Diego announced that all San Diego County residents will be required to wear face coverings while in public starting Friday, May 1, 2020. The new mandate will be added to the County of San Diego public health order that will require anyone to wear a face covering whenever they are within six-feet of a non-household member.

Given the County of San Diego mandatory requirement to wear face coverings in public, all visitors entering all federal courthouses and U.S. Probation and U.S. Pretrial Services offices in this District must wear a face covering effective Friday, May 1, 2020, absent further order of the Court. This Order does not remove or alter any other visitor restrictions set forth in Order of the Chief Judge (OCJ) No. 17-A.

Anyone attempting to enter in violation of this protocol will be denied entry by Court Security Officers.
