Chief Judge No. 46**


On June 10, 2020, upon the recommendations of the Strategic Committee on Resumption of Regular Court Proceedings, the Chief Judge issued Order of the Chief Judge (OCJ) 29 adopting certain safety protocols for in-person proceedings conducted in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California. Many of the circumstances giving rise to the COVID-19 public emergency have not abated since the entry of OCJ 29 (June 10, 2020) or since the subsequent extensions with OCJ 32 (July 6, 2020), OCJ 35 (August 12, 2020), and OCJ 42 (September 10, 2020). To continue to protect the public safety and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Chief Judge hereby extends the safety protocols set forth in that Order.

This Order is effective immediately and will remain in place until November 10, 2020 absent further order of the Court.
